


- 4. Remove the tow hook bolts (1), spacers (2) and nuts (3) from the vehicle, if equipped.
- 5. Remove the front tow hooks (4) from the vehicle, if equipped.
 - Caution: Use the correct fastener in the correct location. Replacement fasteners must be the correct part number for that application.
