



Traditional Clamp




1. Place a clamp (1) over the expanded end of tip (2) as shown.





2. On stock exhaust pipe, measure from the rear most exhaust hanger (1) and mark at the 72mm (3 in) dimension (2) from the hanger as shown. Cut (3) and remove rearward pipe section.

Note: If your stock exhaust pipe has a resonator patch mounted between the rear hanger and cut section, sanding of protruding welds from the patch may be necessary for proper fitment.





Note: Correct flushness of the new exhaust tip is important to prevent burns and scrapes.

3. Using a wire brush, remove any surface dirt or corrosion from the stock exhaust pipe, if necessary. Insert the exhaust tip (1) onto the stock exhaust pipe (2). Push the tip on until it is fully inserted into expanded section. Exhaust tips should be positioned approximately 30mm (1 in) away from rear bumper at their nearest point on the passenger side.

Caution: Use the correct fastener in the correct location. Replacement fasteners must be the correct part number for that application. Fasteners requiring replacement or fasteners requiring the use of thread locking compound or sealant are identified in the service procedure. Do not use paints, lubricants, or corrosion inhibitors on fasteners or fastener joint surfaces unless specified. These coatings affect fastener torque and joint clamping force and may damage the fastener. Use the correct tightening sequence and specifications when installing fasteners in order to avoid damage to parts and systems.

- 4. Tighten the clamp (3) securing the tip to 50 N.m (37 lb ft).
- 5. Before starting your vehicle, make sure to check all wires, hoses, brake lines, body parts and tires for safe clearance from the exhaust system.
- 6. Congratulations, you have completed the installation of your GM Performance Parts Exhaust Tip.



Traditional Clamp



1. Place a clamp (1) over the expanded end of tip (2) as shown. If necessary, use a wire brush to remove any surface dirt or corrosion from the stock exhaust pipe.

- 2. Insert the exhaust tip onto the stock exhaust pipe. Push the tip on until it is approximately 25 mm (1 inch) sub-flush of the bumper or fascia. The stock exhaust pipe should not protrude out of your new exhaust tip.
- 3. Install the tip over the pipe end. Slide the tip up the pipe until the edge meets the mark. Check your exhaust system for proper clearance under the vehicle and also for tip alignment.



- 4. Tighten the clamp securing the tip to 43 N.m (32 lb ft).
- 5. Before starting your vehicle, make sure to check all wires, hoses, brake lines, body parts and tires for safe clearance from the exhaust system.
- 6. Congratulations, you have completed the installation of your GM Performance Parts Exhaust Tip.

Worm Clamp



1. Unscrew the worm gear clamp (2) completely so that it may be inserted through both rectangular holes in the exhaust tip (1) as shown.

Note: Correct flushness of the new exhaust tip is important to prevent burns and scrapes.

- 2. Insert the exhaust tip onto the stock exhaust pipe. The stock pipe should go in between the triangle bracket and the worm gear clamp. Push the tip on until it is approximately 25 mm (1 inch) sub-flush of the bumper or fascia. The stock exhaust pipe should not protrude out of your new exhaust tip.
- 3. Install the tip over the pipe end. Slide the tip up the pipe until the edge meets the mark. Check your exhaust system for proper clearance under the vehicle and also for tip alignment.

Fasteners requiring replacement or fasteners requiring the use of thread locking compound or sealant are identified in the service procedure. 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




1. Place a clamp (2) over the expanded end of tip (1) as shown.





2. Install the tip (1) over the pipe end (2). Slide the tip up the pipe as far as the bend in the exhaust will allow. If you tip has a logo, ensure the logo is facing upward for proper tip alignment.

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- 3. Rotate the clamp (1) so that the clamp bolt (2) is not visible from the exterior of the vehicle. Tighten the clamp securing the tip to 43 N.m (32 lb ft).
- 4. Before starting your vehicle, make sure to check all wires, hoses, brake lines, body parts and tires for safe clearance from the exhaust system.
- 5. Congratulations, you have completed the installation of your GM Performance Parts Exhaust Tip.
